
How to Organize Meetings

for the *21 Days*

Introduction

The purpose of this eBook is to give you **clear, practical steps** on how to organize meetings for the *21 Days of Consecration*. Later, you will also receive another eBook with **exact guidelines** on how to facilitate and guide those meetings during the *21 Days*.

First, if it applies, **remove every fear or doubt**. Don't believe a lie that you can't do this. God has sovereignly placed you in your neighborhood, school, and community—and it is His will that His Church walks in unity (John 17:22).

With this material, you will have **everything you need**—straightforward instructions, tested by the Word and by experience—to gather other believers within your sphere of influence.

Initial Considerations

1. **Pray first.** Jesus is the true Leader of these gatherings. Ask Him for His strategy and to fill you with the knowledge of His will (Colossians 1:9).
2. **Let the Spirit lead.** Every city is different. Every group is unique. Listen to what God wants for your specific context.
3. **Own the mission.** Approach this with the same passion you would if you were planning a stadium event. Why? Because this is even greater—it's for Jesus to inherit your city and nation! Use the resources provided, make your own, share boldly on social media, record videos, call friends. Be intentional. God placed you exactly where you are for such a time as this.
4. **Invite, don't pressure.** Jesus told His disciples to look for the "man of peace" (Matthew 10:14). Some will say yes, some won't. Focus on those who are willing.

What to Communicate

Before inviting others, read the website and review the previous materials (Introduction – Parts 1 & 2).

We've provided some sample messages, but remember: the most effective invitation comes from your heart. Be real, be personal, and share why this matters to you.

Key clarifications if people ask or if you feel needed:

- This movement is not about denominations, ministries, or leaders. It's simply the Body of Christ obeying God's Word.
- Global Consecration is a movement—not a ministry. We are simply serving the Body of Christ.
- Signing up does not mean committing to the full 21 Days or affiliating with a group. It only means you'll receive resources and updates.
- No fees - These meetings are completely free. We recommend no offerings be taken. However, if you are a pastor and need to receive your church's normal offerings, that's fine—or you may place a simple offering box at the back for anyone who wishes to give voluntarily.
- And don't forget to mention: this is global. Believers in over 110 nations are preparing at the same time. When we walk in obedience together, there is greater grace.

General Format of the 21 Days:

- One meeting per day (two if possible).
- Some churches are also doing 24 hours a day
- Each meeting lasts 1–2 hours.
- Includes fellowship, worship, repentance, and intercession.
- No preaching—this is not a typical service.
- At times, there may be a short exhortation or video to provide encouragement and guidance.
- Everyone is invited to actively engage.

Types of Meetings

- Stadium
- Public (plaza, street, etc.)
- Multi-church
- Local church
- Home
- School

1. City-Wide Meetings (Multi-Church)

If you are a pastor, businessperson, or leader, you probably already know many other believers in your city. Use those connections for such a time as this!

Steps:

- Make a list of influential believers (pastors, business leaders, alliance leaders, influencers).
- Download our model invitation letter (available on the website) and adapt to make it personal when you know the person.
- When possible call or message them personally—don't just forward information.
- Ask them to sign up on the website to get the materials.
- Save the contacts of those who respond positively.
- Connect with other pastors and pray together before the 21 Days.
- Decide the best time for meetings (morning or evening).
- Identify possible locations. Prepare permits if needed. Prioritize accessible churches or locations that have adequate seating and sound, etc.

Observations:

- If multiple churches are involved, and the location is not big enough, consider hosting more than one meeting a day.
- Rotate meeting locations to share the load.
- If God leads you to a public space, pray with other pastors about the next steps.
- Worship is optional during the first 14 days. Choose worship leaders with anointing and presence, not just talent.

2. Smaller Meetings

With Your Local Church (Pastors):

If others don't join, lead your own church through the 21 Days. Announce it in services, use the materials, and show excitement. Your people will follow your example.

Homes:

The early Church met in homes for centuries. All you need are open hearts and some chairs. Invite friends, neighbors, and members of different congregations. Rotate homes if needed. Use recorded worship songs if needed.

We also encourage young people to gather and organize home, school or street gatherings.

Schools & Universities (Students):

Invite fellow believers, form a group chat, and start planning. If restrictions exist, we've prepared a sample letter you can use with your school administration. Ultimately, remember Acts 5:29: "We must obey God rather than men."

Start by Yourself:

If no one else is ready yet, start with your family or on your own. Begin praying, repenting, and consecrating yourselves this week.
